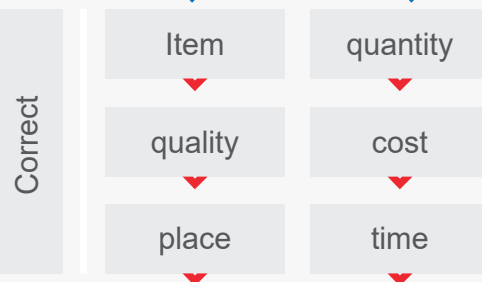
Effectively managing stock for maintenance efficiency
